Communication and Language	<p>Confident Communicators who...</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ★ Speak in longer sentence joined up with words like 'because', 'or' 'and'. ★ Understand simple questions – “Why do you think....” And “I wonder why...”. ★ Explore and use new vocabulary. ★ Follow two step instructions – “Put on your coat and wait by the door”. ★ Ask questions.
Personal, Social and Emotional Development	<p>Independent Individuals who...</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ★ Confidently explore the Nursery and access all the provision areas. ★ Select resources. ★ Manage their own feelings and understand that others have feelings. ★ Use the toilet independently.
	<p>Fantastic Friends who...</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ★ Socially engage with friends. ★ Begin to take turns and share. ★ Form positive relationship with adults. ★ Attempt to find solutions to resolve conflicts.
Physical Development	<p>Amazing Athletes who can...</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ★ Explore different ways of moving, beginning to negotiate space. ★ Climb on and jump off equipment safely. ★ Ride a balance bike.
	<p>Talented Tool Users who can...</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ★ Hold a pen with a comfortable grip and good control. ★ Use scissors to snip. ★ Attempt to do up a zip or fasten buttons.
Literacy	<p>Brilliant Bookworms who ...</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ★ Enjoy listening to stories. ★ Talk about stories and learn new vocabulary. ★ Know and sing at least four nursery rhymes. ★ Are tuning in to how words sound.
	<p>Sentence Superstars who...</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ★ Make marks that look a lot like letters. ★ Write some or all of name.
Mathematics	<p>Masters of Maths who...</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ★ Say one number for each item in order: 1, 2, 3, 4, 5. ★ Recognises representations of numbers up to 5. ★ Compare quantities using language: 'more than', 'fewer than'. ★ Select shapes appropriately for building.
Understanding the World	<p>Exceptional Explorers who...</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ★ Show curiosity about the world around them. ★ Talk about similarities and differences between each other and places. ★ Are respectful of living things.
	<p>Long Ago Learners who...</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ★ Talk about themselves and their family. ★ Explore how things work and how they have changed over time.

Expressive Arts and Design	Dynamic Designers who... ★ Explore colour and colour mixing. ★ Experiment with a variety of media and materials.
	Creative Cooks who ... ★ Know how to make toast and a fruit kebab.
	Proud Performers who... ★ Engage in simple role play, storytelling and singing. ★ Explore sounds and play instruments in different ways.
